

Nanoscale flow phenomena dominated by chemical reactions

There are many nanoscale flows which is dominated by chemical reactions, for instance, proton transfer in polymer electrolyte membrane or dissociation phenomena of gas molecule on metal surface. In this seminar, the characteristics of microscopic interactions between each atoms and the relation between the microscopic phenomena and macroscopic heat and fluid flow is explained using some examples of molecular dynamics simulation.
